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Did You Know?

When you receive a new eyeglass prescription, it is normal to feel mild dizziness after putting on the glasses the first few times. This should not be an ongoing problem. Slight dizziness is most common in patients who receive their first pair of eyeglasses with astigmatism (out-of-roundness of the eyes) lens correction or with progressive (invisible bifocal) lens correction; however, the dizziness should not be persistent. If the dizziness continues for more than a few days, ask the prescribing doctor to recheck the eyeglass prescription that he or she gave you.

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
